The recipient is a woman who has volunteered her time to organized or managed events or initiatives in her community that promoted agriculture and brought farmers and consumers together. The events can be small or large in scale and annual or stand-alone in nature while initiatives can be singular or ongoing.

All nominee's efforts will have had a positive impact on their communities and played a measurable part in inspiring support for the agriculture industry and fostering conversations about the food we grow.

Award Value: \$1000 PER YEAR

The award will be donated to a registered charity or community initiative of the winners choosing.

Award Criteria

-  Nominations are open to all women who are involved in the Saskatchewan agriculture industry.
-  Nominations must be received by the AgriBiz Communications Corp. office by September 30th each year.
-  Nominees must be a resident of Saskatchewan.
-  You may nominate more than one individual.
-  Nominations will be accepted from anyone, including the Women in Ag Board
-  Current Women in Ag board members are not eligible for nomination.
-  A panel of three will select the winner.
